In addition to the Rules and Regulations of the Society, the following regulations apply to competitors and entries in the Sheep Section.

- All rams, including ram lambs, exhibited must come from an Accredited Brucellosis Free Flock. Certificate must be sighted before exhibits are unloaded.
- Sheep infected with footrot or any external parasite will not be allowed to compete and their removal from the Showground will be ordered.
- It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to parade animals for judging. Handlers should preferably wear grey dustcoats.
- Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Judge.
- Classes may be combined or split at the discretion of the Society
