ALPACA SECTION REGULATIONS

In addition to the Rules and Regulations of the Society, the following regulations apply to competitors and entries in the Alpaca Section.

This show is conducted under the current Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association, and the following are to be specifically noted:

- All alpacas must be registered at the time the entry is submitted and must attend the show brass ear-tagged showing its IAR number.
- The age of alpacas is taken as at the date of the show – for example, an alpaca turning 12 months on the show date is shown in the 12-18 months class.
- Huacayas must have a minimum fleece length of 30 mm to a maximum of 60mm and suris a min of 75 mm.
- Alpacas must be penned for inspection by 8.30am and may not be removed from the Showground until 4.00 pm on that day.
- Exhibitors must be present at, and assist in, the inspections. The Chief Steward may disqualify any alpacas not in their allotted pens and available for inspection by that time.

- Entries for the Sires' progeny classes will consist of two animals (not wethers) by the same sire, but not necessarily presented by the same exhibitor, and must have been shown in another class at this show.
- The Chief Steward has the authority to make any determination regarding classes, eligibility and disqualification. Any class may be split, combined or cancelled.
- All handlers entering the show ring must be suitably attired and wear white dust coats. No identification of the exhibitor's stud must be visible.
- Pens are allocated in accordance with JD status, and no changing of pens is permitted.
- Exhibitors must keep their allotted pens clean and tidy, and their animals suitably attended, at all times during the show.
- Judging will commence at 10.00am. All prizes are awarded at the sole discretion of the Judge.
- All alpacas are shown at the owner's risk and the show committee is not responsible for any loss or damage or injury to any exhibit, exhibitor or person, from any cause whatsoever.

MEETING OF EXHIBITORS

The Chief Steward requests that all exhibitors attend a meeting in the show ring at 9.30am.

ADVERTISING

Stud names and banners (to 1500 mm high) are permitted within the allotted pens only.

The following are not permitted:

- Sale signs of any description
- Display of ribbons or awards from any other show any advertising, banners or signs outside the allotted pens
