HORSE SECTION REGULATIONS

WAIVER/INDEMNITY FORM

Each Exhibitor named on the entry form must sign the Waiver/Indemnity form on page 85 (adult) page 87 (under 18)

In addition to the Rules and Regulations of the Society, the following regulations apply to competitors and entries in the Horse Section:

- Horses must either compete in the Show Hunter or Open Hack Classes, they may not compete in both.
- All horses entered in Breed Classes must be registered with their relevant breed society.
- Exhibitors or their agents, when called upon by the Stewards must prove the correctness of their entries.
- The Society reserves the right of adjudicating on any questionable entry or on any such point not provided for in the Regulations of the Society and of making any alterations that may be deemed necessary.
- Riders in hack classes must be suitably attired. A rider or competitor not suitably attired may be excluded by the Stewards from competing in an event.
- All Horses, Galloways or Ponies competing in Height Classes must compete at their correct height. Any "Horses" holding a current official Measuring Certificate will compete at that measurement. However, the Society reserves the right to measure any "Horse" entered in its show.
- Should a Horse, Galloway or Pony be found by the Official Measurer to be over or under height for the class for which it was entered, it may be transferred to a corresponding Horse, Galloway or Pony class at the Steward's discretion.
- In awarding the Championships, unless otherwise stated, the first prize-winner in each class is eligible to compete.
- In awarding the Reserve Championship, unless otherwise stated the first prize-winner in each class other than the Champion is eligible to compete together with the second prize winner from the class or classes from which the champion was drawn.

RESPONSIBILITY:

- The Society will not be responsible for any accidents that may be caused through or by any exhibit, and it shall be the condition of each entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless, and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from such accident.
- The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of exhibits at the Society's exhibition, or for any damage thereto.
- Payment of entry to the Show will be taken as an acceptance of the Society's Rules and Regulations.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to claim any prize money won, in accordance with the Society's Rules and Regulations on the day of the Show.

PROTESTS:

Any exhibitor who desires to enter a protest against any decision on the part of the Judge, or any decision or act or omission on the part of the Society, or of any official of the Society shall lodge a protest in writing within one hour on the day upon which the decision, act or omission occurred. The protest shall set out in detail the circumstances relied upon by such exhibitor and shall be given to or left at the office of Secretary, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00, which shall be forfeited to the Society should the protest be deemed frivolous.

APPEALS:

The right of appeal is granted against any decision given by the Appeal Committee, to the Cumberland Group of Agricultural Societies provided such appeal is made within 48 hours after the decision of the Committee and is accompanied by a fee of \$50.00

OBJECTIONABLE CONDUCT:

Any person who, in the opinion of the Society, or any of its officers shall cause annoyance by loud or unseemly behaviour upon the decision of the Judge or upon an act or omission on the part of the Judge, or any official on duty on or about the Judging ring, and any person whose conduct shall contravene the Society's Rules, Regulations and By-Laws, and its officials by guilty of unseemly or insulting behaviour may be expelled from the Showground and shall upon being requested to do so by the Secretary or by the Steward-in-Chief, or by any official of the Society, forthwith, vacate and leave the Showground or such part thereof as such official shall direct.

If the Committee is satisfied that any person has, by his conduct wilfully infringed the Society's Rules, Regulations and By-Laws, the Committee may prohibit such persons from exhibiting or from competing in any section or class of the Show or any future Show.

JUDGING:

Judging will commence at the time shown in the Official Timetable of events which will be arranged as far as practicable to meet all exhibitors. Competitors are requested to note commencement of classes in the rings. Should they not be in the ring at the commencement of that class, they may be deemed disqualified from competing in that class at the Steward's discretion. A Judge's decision shall in all cases be final.

A Judge in any contest may warn off a horse which in his/her opinion is unfit to be ridden in any such contest.

The Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge where deemed necessary.

If a Judge considers that any exhibit does not possess sufficient merit to deserve a prize, no award will be made.

STALLIONS:

Handlers of Stallions are reminded of their responsibility to keep their charges under control at all times. Stallions are not eligible to compete in any classes other than Stallion Classes. Stallions must be led or ridden by a person over the age of 17 years.

DUE TO NOISE FROM ENTERTAINMENT ON THE FRIDAY & SATURDAY NIGHTS OF THE SHOW, WHICH WILL INCLUDE FIREWORKS ON SATURDAY NIGHT COMMENCING AT 8.00PM.

IT IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT ALL HORSES LEFT OVERNIGHT ON THE SHOWGROUND ARE TO BE SECURED IN DESIGNATED SECURED AND/OR LOCKABLE STABLES.

HORSES MUST NOT BE LEFT UNSECURED AND UNATTENDED DURING THE ENTERTAINMENT PROGRAM ON EITHER NIGHT, PARTICULARLY DURING THE FIREWORKS ON SATURDAY NIGHT.

DEFINITIONS

The age of all riders/ handlers is determined as at the first day of the show. Age of all horses is from 1 August.

SENIOR: a person who is 17 yrs or older

JUNIOR: a person under the age of 17 yrs.

NOVICE HORSE OR RIDER: is one who has not won a first ribbon in a similar event at any Agricultural, Breed. SHC or another recognised Show.

DISTRICT PONY, GALLOWAY OR HACK: must be the property of the Exhibitor who must reside within the Hills or Hornsby Shires.

DISTRICT RIDER: must reside within the Hills or Hornsby Shires.

INTERMEDIATE PONY, GALLOWAY OR HACK: is one which has not won a First, Second or Third placing in a solo event in a similar height class at any Royal Show

CONSOLATION CLASSES: are for horses or riders who have competed in similar events at this Show and who have not won a ribbon on the day of competition.

BROOD MARE: is a Mare from which a foal has been registered with a relevant Society within the last three years, or for which a pregnancy test certificate has been supplied, or which has a foal at foot.

FRIDAY

- All Rings commence 1.00pm
- Stallions/ Colts are only eligible to compete in Stallion or Colt classes only
- All Horses must be registered with the relevant breed society for the classes that they enter. For example horses entering Riding Pony classes must be registered with the Riding Pony Studbook Society.

- 1 The competition may be entered by Pony Clubs affiliated with the Pony Club Association of NSW on the entry form submitted by the Club Secretary, accompanied by an entry fee of \$2.00 per rider.
- 2 A Club may submit one team of no more than 12 riders from the same Club who must be nominated on the entry form. All members of the team must be named, (though substitutes will be accepted on the day if submitted to the chief Steward in the Pony Club ring), and their classes entered on the entry form. As a guide to the number of vehicle passes to be issued, the Secretary should number each competitor on the entry form, (eg 1 Billy Smith), and add a note on the form of those who may be expected to travel in the same float (ie. 1+3, 6+8+9 etc.). The team shall be a maximum of 12 riders, of whom there shall be no more than four (4) in any one of the "riding" classes (although not so in the Pony Club Mount Classes), and all shall be of the age prescribed for the class
- 3 The Pony Club Teams events will, (depending on the number of Teams entered and the time available), be judged in the usual manner in terms of "workout". Concern for "presentation" will be no more than is deemed by the Judge to be appropriate for the event in terms of general appearance and integrity of the Team, ie. there will be no close scrutiny of individual grooming, gear, dress etc., except as may be provided for in Clause d.
- 4 The competition will be conducted in strict accordance with the current rules and regulations of the Association in respect of membership, affiliation, competitions, mounts, equipment and dress.
